MINUTE OF HARRISON J

---

[1]      On 29 October Mr Greer has appealed against his conviction and sentence to a term of preventative detention. His notice of appeal lists multiple grounds which will require refinement and particularity before a fixture is allocated.

[2]      Mr Greer has also lodged with the Registry a handwritten document purporting to be, among other things, a notice of appeal against a judgment delivered by Goddard J in the High Court refusing an application for habeas corpus. In fact, the Judge issued a minute on that date, directing that the application itself was so defective that the Court should not receive it. Accordingly there is no judgment against which an appeal would lie to this Court which has no jurisdiction to determine Mr Greer’s purported appeal.
